The workshops were designed for Polish science teachers from the region of Mazovia and Warsaw and took place in Warsaw.

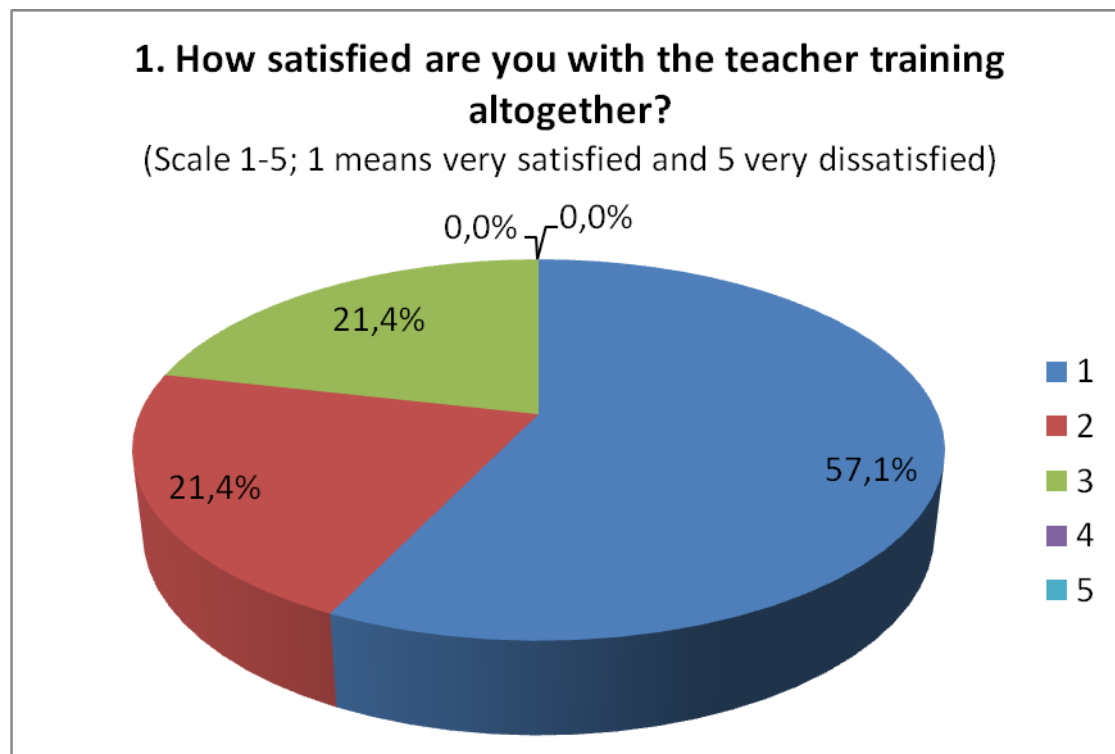
For teachers from Mazovian Region in MSCDN (Mazovia Regional Centre of Teacher Training in Warsaw) there were two workshops:

- 29 October 2013 – participated 12 teachers
- 5 December 2013 – participated 21 teachers

For teachers from Warsaw in WCIES (Warsaw Centre for Educational and Social Innovation and Training for Teachers) there were two workshops:

- 21 November 2013 – participated 11 teachers
- 3 December 2013 – participated 14 teachers

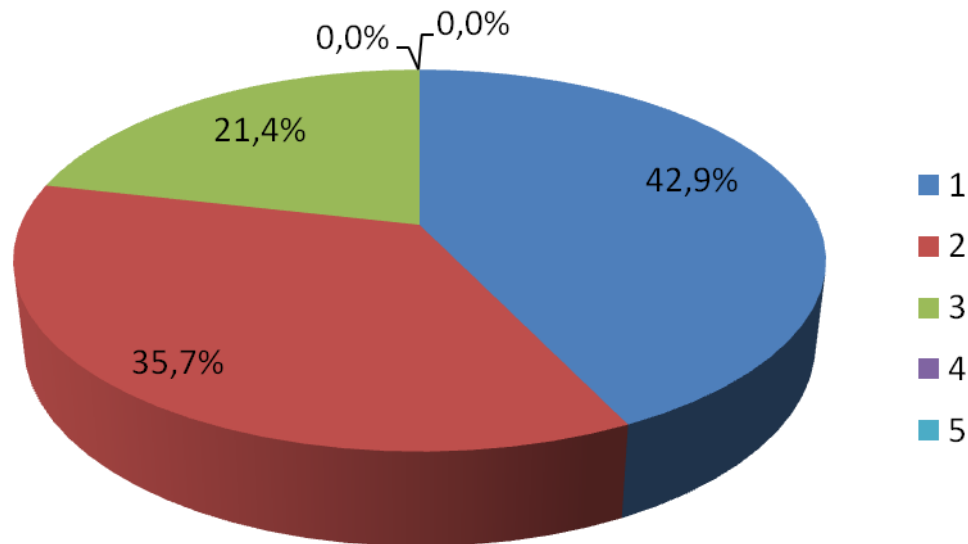

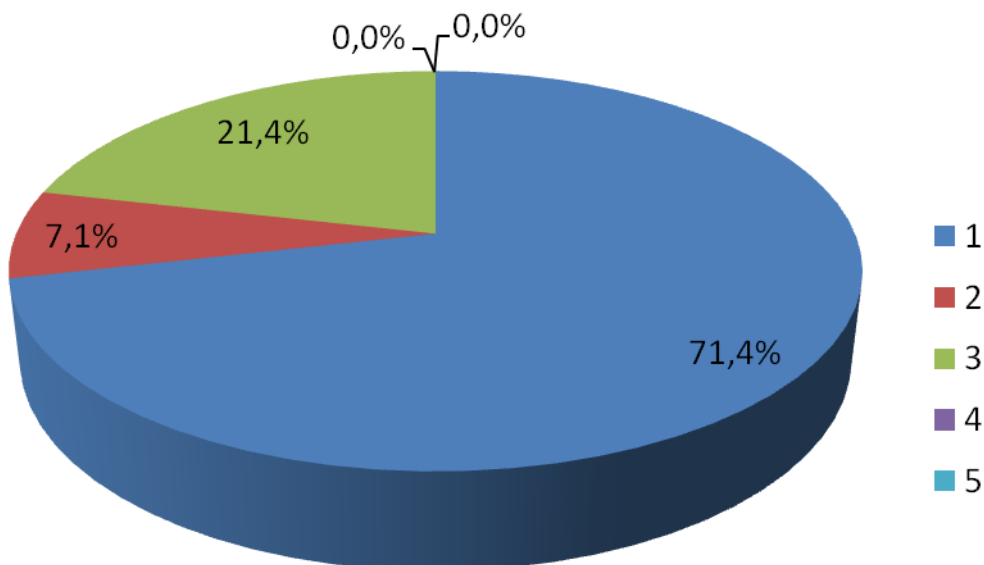
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2. How inspiring has it been for your lessons?

(Scale 1-5; 1 is very inspiring and 5 not inspiring at all)

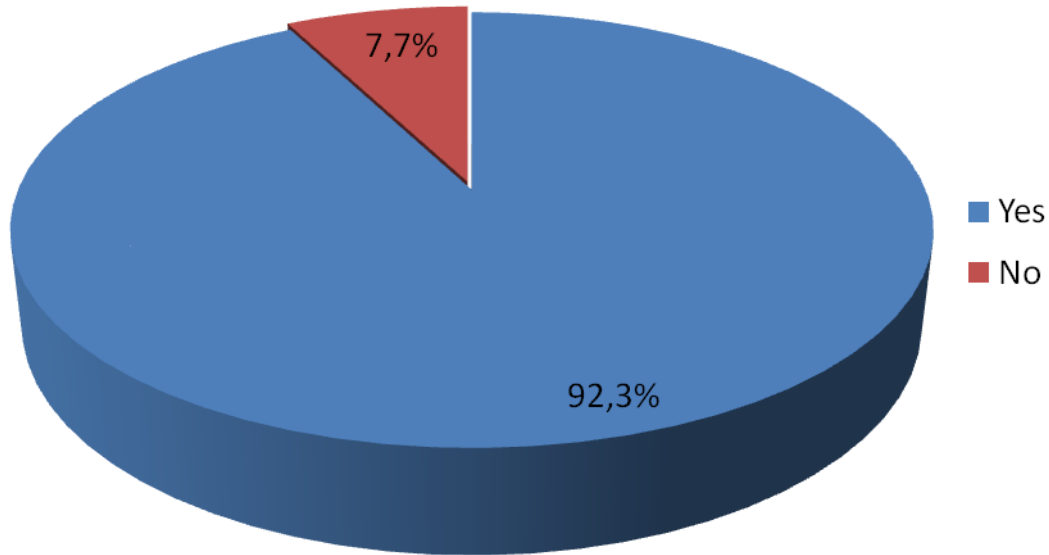
**3. How do you like the publication?**

(Scale 1-5; 1 means very much and 5 not at all)

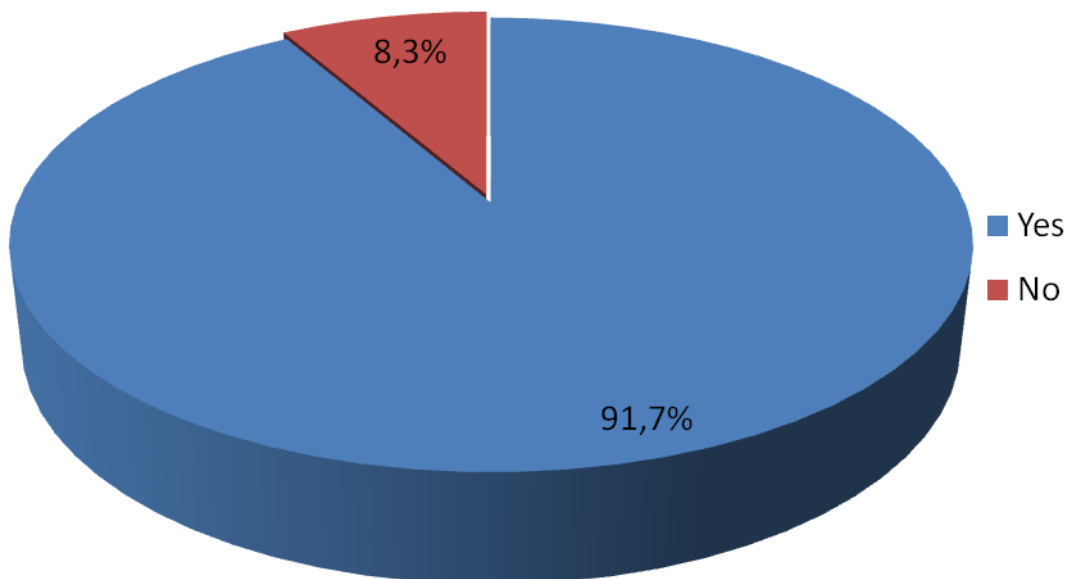


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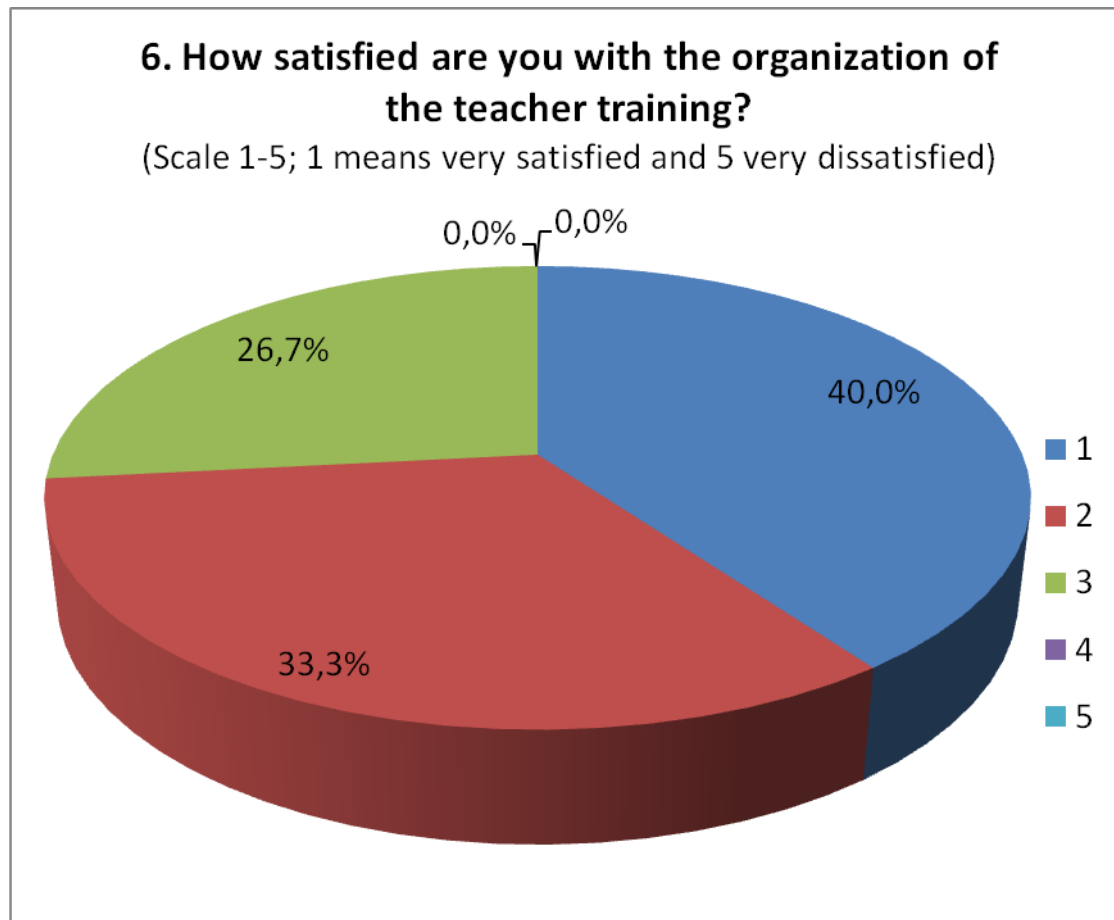
4. Do you think the publication will be useful for your lessons?
