

Role play: Choosing apples



Imagine you go into a local supermarket to buy some apples in spring. There you meet a friend who is choosing the cheapest apples on sale. While you are scanning the offer, you start a dialogue with your friend about buying apples.

Work assignment:

- 1) Think of arguments and facts about apples that you can use to convince your friend that there are more important matters than just the price. Keep in mind what you just did using the material provided about buying apples in Europe in April.
- 2) Write down your arguments and put them in a ranked order. The most important argument at the top, the least important argument at the bottom of your list.
- 3) Write out a dialogue between the two of you.
- 4) Practice the dialogue and be prepared to present it in class.
